MAD is seeking director submissions for its 2020 Fall Show! Candidates are allowed to submit for up to five shows each. Each show will be considered as a separate submission, even when presented by the same director. Each submission may also include production and artistic staff members as needed, which may be considered stronger candidate shows.

The Fall Show is considered a large cast musical which will include a variety of opportunities for MAD members in acting, music, and dance. The submission for each show shall include the director’s name, the director’s resume, proposed staff (which may include producer, music director, stage designer, etc.), and your vision for the show. The vision shall present how the show will work for MAD and its audience. This may include a brief synopsis of the show, potential cast demographics, type of dances required, casting flexibility (gender flips/double casting), information on technical aspects, stage layout plans, how to manage dated/sensitive material, and other information the director considers important to the submission.
