MAD Condolences

Thanks for **Christa Kronser** for this piece:

On Saturday, January 11, **Kevin Wells**, **Chris's** older son, passed away. Kevin has been part of the MAD family for over 20 years, since 1997's "The Mystery of Edwin Drood."

On November 26, Kevin went into cardiac arrest at home for 10 minutes. He was transported to Baltimore Washington Medical Center, where he remained on respiratory life support for 46 days (including his 42nd birthday on December 15). Kevin's family made the impossible decision to remove him from life support on January 10. Doctors informed the Wells family that Kevin hadn't been breathing on his own since admittance to the hospital and that he would pass within a minute of being taken off the ventilator. In true Kevin fashion (defying the odds until the end), Kevin struggled for breath momentarily, then began breathing steadily on his own for over 14 hours, until he decided it was his time and left the world at 10:37, January 11.

Kevin's viewing will be on Friday, Jan. 17 at Singleton Funeral Home, 1 Second Ave. SW, Glen Burnie, MD 21061, with visiting hours from 3-5 and 7-9 pm. The Mass of Christian Burial will take place at St. Philip Neri Catholic Church on Saturday, January 18 at 12:30pm. (6405 S. Orchard Rd, Linthicum, MD.)

In lieu of flowers, the family has requested donations to Cure SMA, an organization dedicated to funding research to discover and develop a treatment and cure for SMA. 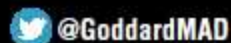

Act I Cast
