Fantasia MADness 2023 Variety Show Brings Song and Dance Back to the Center!!



Visitor's Badge Access to Goddard: FAQs

Who needs a Visitor's Badge? Anyone who does not have a Goddard PIV or current club badge must obtain a Visitor's badge to get on Center.

How do I get a Visitor's Badge for the show? Reserve a ticket on-line before 5:00 pm on May 30. Bring your ticket and a government ID to check in at the new Badging Office in Bldg. 17 on IceSat Road (formerly Soil Conservation Road) at least 30 minutes prior to the show.

Do I need a government ID to get a ticket? Anyone 16 or older must have a government ID to get on Center. When reserving a ticket on-line, enter your name exactly as it appears on the government ID in the box provided. Government IDs include driver's license, Federal/State/local agency ID (including a GSFC badge), military ID, student ID, Permanent Resident Card, U.S. Passport. Non-citizens must show a Permanent Resident Card. GSFC-badged employees do not need to check in at Bldg. 17.

How do I get from the Badging Office to the Building 3 auditorium? Follow the escort who will meet you at the Badging Office. Show your Visitor's Badge and government ID at the gate on IceSat road and follow signs to Building 3. The ticket will include a map.

What if I want tickets for a group of people? Reserve tickets for the whole group on-line, including both badged and un-badged people. Enter each individual's name exactly as it appears on their government ID in the box provided.

Why can't we do what we used to do? Goddard security rules have changed. All visitors must have their access approved by security ahead of time.

Call for MAD Fall Show and Director

As President of MAD, I am very excited to announce that MAD is seeking submissions for its 2023 Fall Show and director! As a change from previous years, the submitter does not need to be the director of the show. Additionally, candidates can apply to be the Fall Show director without attachment to a show. If submitting for shows, candidates are allowed to submit up to five. Each show will be considered a separate submission, even when presented by the same person. Each submission may also include production and artistic staff members as needed, which may be considered stronger candidate shows/directors.

The Fall Show is considered a large cast musical which will include a variety of opportunities for MAD members in acting, music, and dance. The submission for each show shall include the director's name (if applicable), the director's resume (if applicable), proposed staff (which may include producer, music director, stage designer, etc.), and your vision for the show. The vision shall present how the show will work for MAD and its audience. This may include a brief synopsis of the show, potential cast demographics, type of dances required, casting flexibility (gender flips/double casting), information on technical aspects, stage layout plans, how to manage dated/sensitive material, and other information the submitter considers important. If submitting as a director, include your resume and any pertinent information about your directing style.
